About the SEMINAR

The NAAC-sponsored National Seminar on "Post NAAC Accreditation Scenario in Higher Education Institution", will provide the much needed platform for a brainstorming session to stir up the continued effort of the Head of institutions, IQAC team members, teachers and other associated people for improvement of a higher educational institute (HEI) in the subsequent phase after an accreditation process. The assessment and accreditation processes have proved to be very effective in grading the HEIs. At the same time for the subsequent cycles it has great relevance in up-gradation of HEIs. Clearly, there is indeed a need to ensure that the gusto of the team effort is maintained all along. Studies reveals that for a good number of HEIs in India including that in Northeast India, that have been assessed and accredited and fared satisfactorily in the first cycle, but have failed to make any improvement in subsequent assessments or rather maintain the initial standards resulting in being graded down. There is, thus, an utmost need to ensure that a quality improvement subsequent to the accreditation process is undertaken by an HEI. Contribution from different stakeholders, e.g., teaching and non-teaching staff, HEI administrations, governments, guardians and alumni etc. The actual objective of accreditation processes - continuous quality improvements of HEIs can be ensured only through such combined effort. This seminar throws open a platform for participants to share their valuable opinions and expertise gathered through firsthand experience for the steps and methods that can be adopted for quality improvement to pave way for embracing necessary measures first to maintain and then push for further improvement of the HEIs. Consequently, the stakeholders will be aware of their roles and responsibilities and the various possibilities for quality improvement in the post accreditation scenario. So, the positive impact of this conference on quality improvement in post-accreditation scenario will light up the path for HEIs of India, especially for HEIs of Northeast which have their own constraints and challenges resulting in better grades in subsequent accreditations and assessments.
